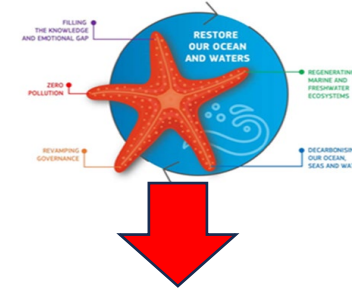

Mission objectives and targets

Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030

PROTECT AND RESTORE MARINE AND FRESHWATERS ECOSYSTEMS AND BIODIVERSITY

- Protect at least 30% and strictly protect 10% EU's sea areas
- Restore 25.000 km free flowing rivers
- Marine nature restoration targets (incl. degraded seabeds, coastal ecosystems)

PREVENT AND ELIMINATE POLLUTION OF OUR OCEANS, SEAS AND WATERS

- Reduce by at least 50% plastic litter
- Reduce by at least 30% microplastics
- Reduce by at least 50% nutrient losses, chemical pesticides

MAKE THE BLUE ECONOMY CARBON- NEUTRAL AND CIRCULAR

- Net zero maritime emissions
- Zero carbon aquaculture,
- Low carbon multipurpose use of marine space

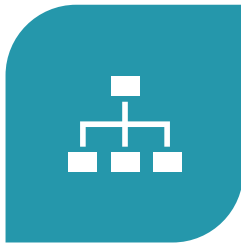

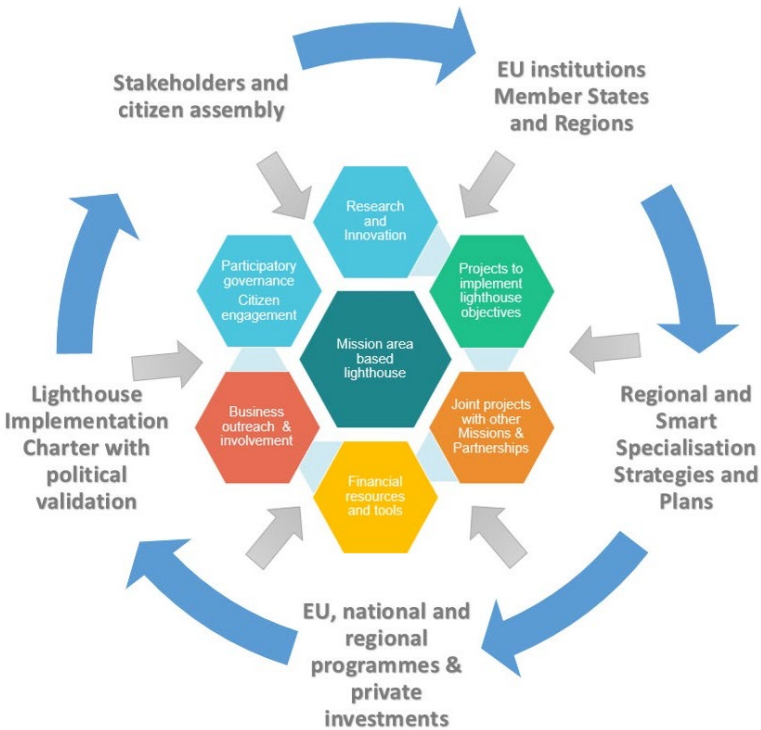

2024: Algeria, Egitto, Malta, Tunisia, Turchia

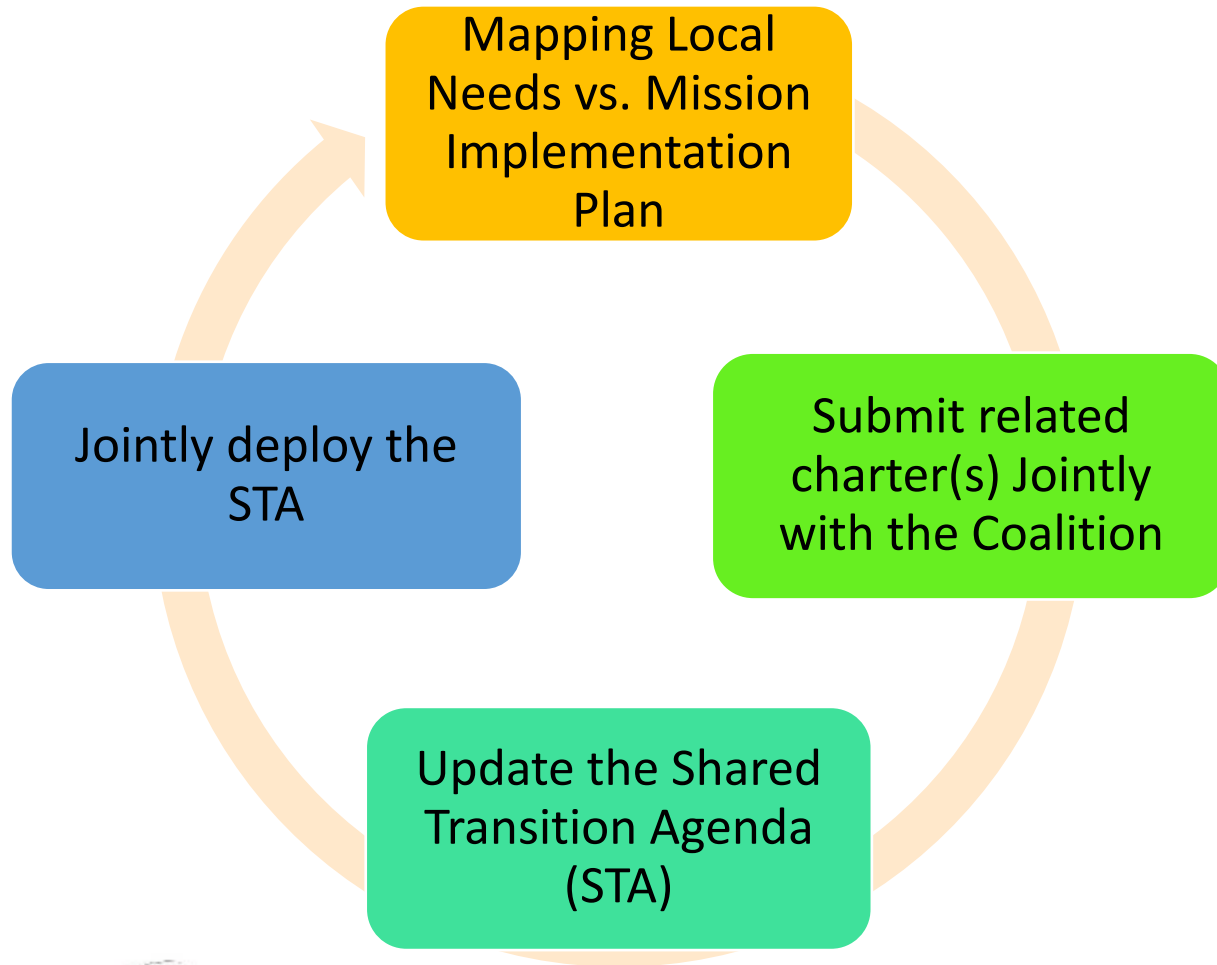
26 June 2023, the Coalition:

- **Counts** 28 Municipalities, 1 County (grouping 21 Municipalities) and 1 Association (grouping 200 Municipalities), 1 FLAG and 1 Regional Park
- **Represents** 249 Municipalities (224 in Italy, 35 in Spain) totalling 4.190.430 citizens (data 2021)
- **Covers** coastlines (164 municipalities) and inner regions (85 municipalities)
- **Originated** 30 Charters for an aggregated budget of 392,41 M€

The number of Municipalities and the geographical coverage is expected to grow significantly.



How can we best contribute? Identified synergies, concerted planning, coordinated implementation, etc



The Coalition's **coordinated implementation**:

Facilitates an effective deployment

Ensures concerted planning and complementarity

Builds the critical mass, so important for small municipalities

Allows for mutual learning

Integrates small municipalities (behind)

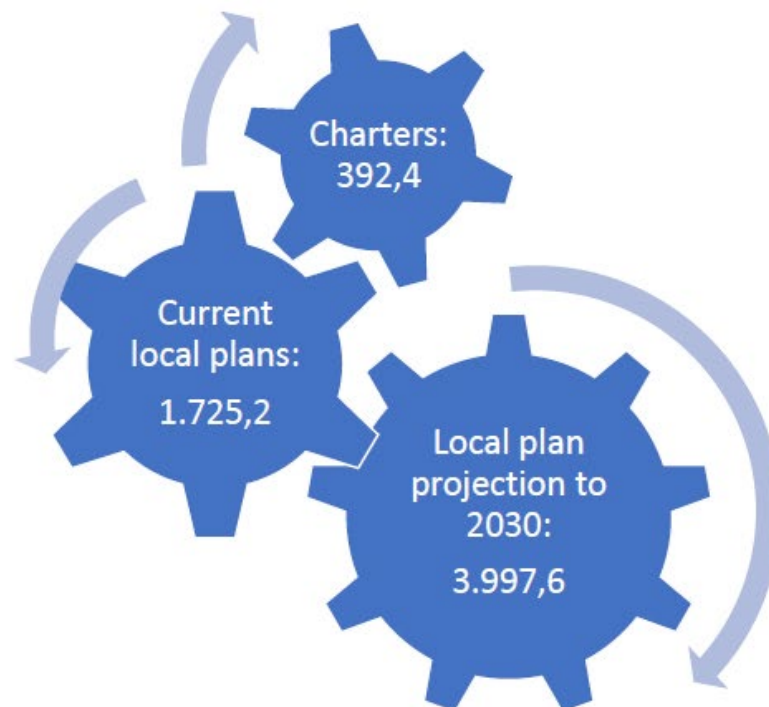
