Marco Maglionico is Associate Professor of Hydrology and Hydraulic and Maritime Structures at the University of Bologna.

He graduated in Hydraulic Engineering in 1993 from the University of Bologna with top marks and honors.

He teaches “Urban Hydraulic Systems Project” for the Master's Degree in Civil Engineering and “Circular-green management of urban drainage” for the Master's Degree in Civil Engineering at the School of Engineering and Architecture of the University of Bologna.

The research activity mainly concerns topics in the field of hydraulic networks: urban drainage systems and aqueduct systems.

These activities have also been conducted within the framework of National and European Research Projects as well as through various agreements and collaborations with public and private entities.

The research activity has led to the creation of over 100 scientific publications both in journals and in national and international conferences.

He has been a member of the CSDU (Centro Studi idraulica Urbana) since 1996. Since 2018 he has been carrying out the role of Auditor.
