PROFILE

Roberto Zocchi has more than 30 years of experience in the water and environmental sectors. Having coordinated the strategic alliance between ACEA S.p.A. of Rome, one of the major utility Companies in Italy, and the British WRc – Water Research Centre, in his career acquired extensive experience covering the position of Chief Executing Officer, Chairman and President in primary Engineering, Innovation and water treatment Companies where he achieved great results in merging, acquiring and organizing whole branches.

With a solid technical engineering background, he has developed specific skills in economic regulation of public services and in Public Private Partnerships, applying the wide experience that WRc gained in reorganization of the UK water services. He was directly involved in the implementation of the law for the reorganization of the Italian Water Industry, giving support to the central govern (Ministries – central regulator) in setting the Water Tariff Method and related procedures, and to local governs (Regions) in the process of regionalization and concentration of the water services.

Expert in corporate transactions, financial planning and budgets, he applied his regulation experience in Italy, where, as President of CSM - Centro Sviluppo Materiali (now RINA consulting), led its acquisition by the RINA group; internationally as world Bank partner and in Europe, as Chairman of the Commission 3 “Legal & Economic Affairs” of EurEau – the European Federation of Water Management Associations, where, during his chairmanships, focused the activity of the Federation on the economic sustainability of the water sector (asset serviceability and investments).

He is author of several scientific and managerial papers, presented memories in various national and international congresses and held specific Master courses at the LUISS University of Rome, Bocconi University of Milan, Scuola Sant’Anna of Pisa and other prestigious Universities.

He recently expanded his expertise in the renewable energy and waste sector as CEO and then Chairman of Andion Italy, a leading company in the production of biomethane plants, and as a member of the board of directors of Ind.Eco, a company belonging to the Greenthesi Group. At the same time, he continues to serve as Secretary General of the prestigious Associazione Idrotecnica Italiana (Italian Hydrotechnical Association).
