



## **SIMONA RAMBERTI**

Simona Ramberti has been working as a senior technologist at the National Institute of Statistics of Italy (Istat), in the field of environmental statistics since 2006, with a specific focus on water resources. Since 2020, she has been responsible for the Urban Water Census, a survey conducted as part of the Italian National Statistical Programme that monitors the entire supply chain, from the withdrawal of water for drinking purposes to the treatment of urban waste water.

She is a member of the National Commission for the Prediction and Prevention of Major Risks – Forest Fire Risk and Water Deficit sector – and participates in numerous working groups and technical committees at national (MASE, DPC, ISS) and international (FAO, UNECE, UNSD, OECD, Eurostat) level. Simona Ramberti is the contact person for Eurostat/OECD/FAO data collection on water statistics and for Goal 6 “Clean water and sanitation” of the SDGs.

She participates in the definition of estimates on non-civil uses of water and collaborates with ISPRA in the assessment of the hydrological and water balance at national and river basin district level and the indicators derived from it. She is also an expert member of the permanent district observatories on water uses.
